

## Dwight City Council Minutes

January 19th, 2015

The Dwight City Council met in regular session at 7 PM on January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Mayor Galen Johnson presided and opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members present were Pam Goss, Eddie Vineyard and Kathy Worrell. Councilwoman Ellis and Councilman Traynor were absent.

Visitors present: Mina Miller, Butch Roberts, Ricky Worrell, Donnie Glessner, and Chris Stewart.

Additions to Agenda: None

Minutes: Councilwoman Goss moved to accept the minutes of the December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2014 regular meeting as presented. Councilwoman Worrell seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Maintenance Manager Report: Donald Glessner in attendance and provided a written report. Everything is going good at the sewer ponds. He removed some limbs from the fence. He would like to attend the KRWA Conference in March. He told Council that more grape stuff needs to be ordered.

Water Manager Report: Brad Reynoso was not in attendance but provided a written report. He requested a reflective vest to wear as he is reading meters. He told Council he would like to tint the windows in the City Office. Council tabled any decision until the February meeting.

Dog Catcher Report: Ricky Worrell was in attendance and provided a written report. He reported a couple of dogs outside of town. The owners picked up the dogs.

City Treasurer Report: Mina Miller was in attendance and provided Council with the Quarterly and End-of-Year Financials. She asked Council to sign off on the reports and approve the year end publication so she can send it to the paper to be published.

City Clerk Report: Heather Brown reviewed the financial reports. She had Council sign paperwork to begin the audit process with Aldrich & Company. She also had Council sign a thank you card for the Dwight Library board for allowing the City Office to reside in the Library for so long. She shared the amount of the County Treasurer's tax distribution check for the quarter. Councilwoman Goss made a motion to order a labor all in one poster for \$10.00. Councilman Vineyard seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Review and approval of bills: Councilwoman Worrell moved to approve the bills as presented. Councilwoman Goss seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Correspondence: Heather shared a thank you card from Santa Clause. He thanked Council for the \$50 donation they made to purchase candy. She also shared a letter from Westar regarding street lights changing over to LED lights this year. Heather provided Council with a release of final payment from Riley Construction for the new City Office.

Old Business: Mayor Johnson attended the last School Board meeting. Councilwoman Worrell asked what will happen to the trophies and banners in Prairie Heights Elementary School once it is closed. This discussion will be revisited at the February Council meeting.

New Business: Mayor Johnson discussed with Council the possibility of donating some money to the Dwight City Library to help purchase an outside book drop. This discussion was tabled until the February meeting. Heather will call about having the snowflakes on Main Street taken down.

Adjournment: Councilwoman Goss made the motion to adjourn with Councilwoman Worrell seconding. Motion carried 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM.
