RECYCLING

Did you know that the City has a recycling center? It is located on the east end of the City maintenance shop on Highway 57 next to the old gas station. Each Thursday, the Morris County Recycling Center truck comes to Dwight to collect the items. They accept the following items: newspaper, magazines, phone books, white and colored paper, tin cans, #1 clear plastic, #2 plastic (milk jugs), #2 colored plastic (laundry soap bottles), film plastic (grocery bags), cardboard, electronics, waste motor oil, scrap metal, batteries and scrap aluminum.



DOG REGISTRATIONS

If you still need to get your pet registered, please bring proof of rabies vaccination to the City Office along with your payment of \$7 for spayed/neutered dog and \$10 for un-spayed/unneutered dog. We did register a few cats this year, so if you would choose to register your cat please feel free to do so. Dog registrations expire on April 30th each year.
