

Dwight Special City Council Minutes

September 3rd, 2016

The Dwight City Council met in special session at 9 AM on September 3rd, 2016 for the purpose of discussing purchasing Block 67, Lots 1-8 from USD 417. Mayor Galen Johnson presided. Council members present were Pam Goss, Richard Lindgren, John Traynor and Kathy Worrell. Mayor Johnson explained the reason for the meeting. Superintendent Doug Conwell met with him on August 29th, 2016. At that time, Mr. Conwell told Mayor Johnson that Linda Carr was to purchase the Dwight School building but not Block 67, Lots 1-8. USD 417 wanted to give the City the first opportunity to bid on the lots. Councilwoman Goss and Mayor Johnson agreed to call the Special meeting. If the City were to purchase the land, it would not go on the tax role. The school building closed on September 1st, 2016. Council discussed the extra mowing purchasing the land would require. Councilwoman Goss stated that it would not make sense to build another City Park on the land and that we would only utilize the land once every five years during Summerfest. After much discussion, no action was taken.

Councilwoman Goss moved to adjourn. Councilwoman Worrell seconded. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:30 AM.
