

Dwight City Special Council Minutes

February 13, 2013

The Dwight City Council met in special session at 7 PM on February 13, 2013 for the purpose of discussing the community building grant application. Mayor Galen Johnson presided and began the meeting with the pledge of allegiance. Councilmembers present were Kenny Kaluhiokalani, Eugene Anders, Eddie Vineyard, Pam Goss and Melissa Ellis. City Clerk Lisa Lee took minutes. In addition, twenty-seven community members were in attendance.

The meeting began with an apology by Councilwoman Goss. Architect Ben Moore explained his written report concerning the current condition of the building. Jay Evans reported his findings after inspecting under the building. Much discussion about whether to remodel or build a new building followed with input from the community members present. Councilman Vineyard moved to file a pre-application for a USDA Community Facilities Grant to construct a new community building/library/City Office at a cost of \$375,000. Councilman Anders seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Councilman Vineyard moved to adjourn with Councilwoman Ellis seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
