

## Dwight City Council Minutes

July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting on July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 7 pm. Meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm. Mayor Galen Johnson opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.
