

## Dwight City Council Minutes

October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020

The Dwight City Council met for a regular Meeting on October 19th, 2020 at 7 PM. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were John Traynor, Peter Marquardt and Susan Mulryan. Aubrey Evans and Brenda Switzer were absent.

Also Present: City Treasurer Mina Miller, Water Manager Ryan Taylor, Maintenance Manager Donald Glessner, Animal Control Officer Justin Litke and City Clerk Heather Brown.

Visitors present: Jessie Batten and Nancy Evans

Additions to agenda: None.

Minutes: Councilman Traynor moved to accept the minutes of the September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 regular meeting as presented. Councilman Marquardt seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Maintenance Manager Report: Donald Glessner provided a written report. He reported that the sewer facilities are in good shape and operating well. Councilwoman Mulryan moved to have NAPA service the Hustler mower. Councilman Marquardt seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Water Manager Report: Water Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Biological samples have all come back normal.

PRIDE Report: Angela Harris was not present and did not provide a report.

Animal Control Report: Justin Litke provided a written report. He would like to set penalties for chicken violations. Council will set up a working meeting to discuss ordinances in the near future. Councilman Traynor stated that he will speak with the owners of the chickens that are in violation.

City Treasurer Report: Mina Miller provided council with a written quarterly report.

City Clerk Report: Heather provided written reports and financials. She has completed the quarterly tax reports. She set up a payment agreement with a resident who has fallen behind on their utility bill due to a major leak. The customer will pay an extra \$75 per month on top of their normal bill until they are caught up.

Review and approval of bills: Councilman Traynor moved to approve the bills with the exception of SUEZ until a report is received by them. Councilman Marquardt seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Old Business: Ryan stated that he is still working on the fascia board for the community building. Council reviewed the bid from Fox Home Innovations. Councilwoman Switzer is working on gathering other bids. The municipal court ordinance will be discussed in the working meeting. The tennis court repairs were discussed. There are enough straight poles available but concrete needs to be removed from them. There is also enough top rail but some are

slightly bent. The most that will be needed to complete the project is around \$100 to pay for caps, concrete etc. Heather will try to find volunteers to help Councilman Traynor and Councilman Marquardt with the project.

Councilman Marquardt made the motion to get a 30 yard dumpster from RNR Rolloff for the city wide clean up on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Councilwoman Mulryan seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Mayor Goss and Councilman Traynor met with Mark Wishon regarding 8<sup>th</sup> and Oak Street estimates for repair. He will get an estimate to council. They discussed doing an angle tube.

New Business: Mayor Goss would like to do employee evaluations at the November council meeting. The council work day will also be scheduled at the November meeting.

Open Forum: Ryan stated that he will not be around to help out with the city-wide cleanup.

Adjournment: Councilman Marquardt made the motion to adjourn with Councilman Traynor seconding. Motion carried 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 8:37 PM. The next regularly scheduled Council meeting will be held on November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 7 PM.
