

Dwight City Council Minutes

April 19th, 2021

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the Dwight United Methodist Church on April 19th, 2021 at 7 PM. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were John Traynor, Peter Marquardt, Brenda Switzer and Susan Mulryan. Aubrey Evans was absent.

Also Present: Maintenance Manager Donald Glessner, Water Manager Ryan Taylor, City Clerk Heather Brown, City Treasurer Mina Miller and Animal Control Officer Justin Litke.

Visitors present: Nancy Evans, Anna Mae Robidou, Chris Stewart, Marilyn Smith, Connie Burton, Gary Burton, Betty Morgan, Jean Johnson, Cindy Cronin, Angela Harris, and Deb Brown. Marc Smith arrived at 8:41 PM.

Minutes: Councilwoman Mulryan moved to accept the minutes of the March 2021 regular meeting as presented. Councilman Traynor seconded. Motion carried 4-0. Councilman Traynor moved to accept the minutes of the April 5th, 2021 special meeting as presented. Councilman Marquardt seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Maintenance Manager Report: Donald Glessner provided a written report. He reported that the sewer facilities are in good shape and operating well. NAPA serviced the Hustler mower. He requested that the supplies that are being used to repair the tennis court fence be moved so he can mow and weedeat.

Water Manager Report: Water Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Biological samples have all come back normal. He stated that there will be baseball practices held in Dwight this summer and possibly games.

PRIDE Report: Angela Harris was present. The April Summerfest meeting was cancelled. About 20 surveys were returned back to her regarding Summerfest 2022. The meetings will be held on the first Monday of each month at 6:30 on Googlemeet. The link will be posted to the city website and city facebook page prior to each meeting.

City Treasurer Report: Mina Miller provided council with the quarterly treasurer's report.

City Clerk Report: Heather provided written reports and financials. She shared a letter from a resident. She reported that she submitted the annual USDA report, the first quarter Wastewater Monitoring Report, first quarter Water Protection & Clean Drinking Water report, the monthly 941 tax deposit and the annual EMC Insurance audit requisition.

Review and approval of bills: Councilwoman Mulryan moved to approve the bills as presented. Councilman Marquardt seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Old Business: There was extensive discussion regarding the current issues with the community building/Library. There continues to be research and discussion on the issues. A Special city council meeting will be held on May 6th, 2021 at 7 PM to continue ongoing discussion regarding the building,

New Business: The city-wide garage sales will be held on June 12th, 2021 and the city-wide clean-up will be held on June 19th, 2021 from 8 am-11:30 am. Council is looking into providing a dumpster again this year for the city-wide clean-up.

Mask requirements during meetings, the Water, Sewer and Trash Ordinance & Resolution and Dog Ordinance were all tabled until a later meeting.

Open Forum: Nancy Evans thanked Council members for their hard jobs and thanked everyone who attended the meeting. Mayor Goss thanked Nancy Evans and the Dwight United Methodist Church for the use of the building. There is a \$15 fee for the city to use the building for city council meetings.

Adjournment: Councilman Marquardt made the motion to adjourn with Councilwoman Switzer seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:26 PM. The next regularly scheduled Council meeting will be held on May 17th, 2021 at 7 PM.
