

Dwight City Council Minutes

June 16th, 2025

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the City Office on June 16th, 2025, at 7:00pm. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were Susan Mulryan, Ashley Gearhart, Chelsey Brosious, and Adam Wiebe.

Also Present: Ryan Taylor, Ken Bergeron, Mark Rogers, Andy Masenthin and Cindy Jensen

Vistor Comments: Mark Rogers introduced himself to Council, with Council and City employees introducing themselves in turn. Mark explained he moved into town about a year ago, lives on 6th St. and plans to attend meeting to be more involved with Dwight community.

Andy Masenthin discussed with Council his request to have late fee removed, and previous letters he had presented. Andy asked that notification be sent when a letter is received as follow-up.

Additions to Agenda: Cindy Jensen presented proposed 2026 City of Dwight Budget. After discussion it was suggested to raise the RNR by 3%.

Councilwoman Mulryan made a motion to increase the Revenue Neutral Rate for 3.5 mil Levy for the proposed 2026 City of Dwight Budget. Councilman Weibe seconded. Motion carried 4-0

Minutes: Councilwoman Mulryan moved to accept the minutes with noted corrections of the May 19th, 2025, regular meeting. Councilwoman Gearhart seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0

Maintenance Manager Report: Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report.

Water Manager Report: Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report.

City Clerk Report: Clerk Ken Bergeron provided a written report and financials. Ken reported the number of delinquent accounts, and that payment was received from each account holder.

Review and Approval of Bills: Councilwoman Gearhart moved to approve the bills for a total of \$7,849.12. Councilwoman Mulryan seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0

New Business: Ken to send a letter and copy of Resolution 2024-7-15 to explain Council's Decision and reason why to Andy Masenthin.

Old Business:

Councilwoman Mulryan continues working on income and receipts for budget information.

Nuisance letters were mailed to the same numerous property locations discussed at May 19th meeting.

Park Cleanup specifically tree and brush trimming and removal will be postponed to fall at more acceptable temperatures for heavy laborious work.

Open Forum: Councilman Wiebe and Ken will review current process for delivery of city bills and explore if other options are available and sensible for the City of Dwight.

Adjournment: Councilwoman Gearhart moved to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:54pm. Councilwoman Brosious seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0. The next regular council meeting will be held on July 21st , at 7pm. Location will be the City Library.
