

## Dwight City Council Minutes

April 15, 2024

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the Library on April 15th, 2024 at 7:00PM. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were, Susan Mulryan, Chelsey Brosious, and Ashley Gearhart.

*Minutes:* Councilwoman Brosious moved to accept the minutes of the March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024 regular meeting as presented. Councilwoman Gearhart seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

*Maintenance Manager Report:* Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Ken will call Services Unlimited to repair electrical line at snack bar in the ballfield.

*Water Manager Report:* Water Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Ryan reported that he passed test. Ryan discussed bids for pit removal of \$1800.00, and \$500.00 to place concrete around pits. Culverts could be cut in half to protect pits, this would involve renting a saw from Adams Lumber.

*City Clerk Report:* Ken Bergeron provided written report and financials. Ken reported that the large outstanding account was paid in full.

Councilwoman Mulryan made motion to go into Executive session for 20 minutes to discuss Ryan Taylor annual performance review. Councilwoman Gearhart seconded. Motion carried 3-0

Councilwoman Mulryan made a motion to go into Regular session. Councilwoman Gearhart seconded. Motion carried 3-0

Councilwoman Mulryan made a motion to increase Ryan Taylor wage \$2.00 per hour to begin with the next pay period. Councilwoman Brosious seconded. Motion carried 3-0
