July 17, 2023

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the Library on July 17, 2023 at 7:00PM. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were Peter Marquardt, Brenda Switzer, Susan Mulryan, and Ashley Gearhart
