

Dwight City Council Minutes

July 21st, 2025

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the City Office on July 21st, 2025, at 7:00pm. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were Susan Mulryan, Ashley Gearhart, Peter Marquardt, and Adam Wiebe.

Also Present: Ryan Taylor, Ken Bergeron, Jean Johnson, Galen Johnson, Andy Masenthin

Visitor Comments: Andy Masenthin discussed the future need for water meter and service at two locations. Andy also inquired about changing property numbers from 428 to 440. After discussion council informed Andy that City Council will need to check with Morris County to gather the details involved with changing the Number.

Galen Johnson answered questions about the future rent payments made by City of Dwight for the Dwight Library. Galen Johnson informed the council that a discussion will be held at the next meeting of Dwight Community Development Corporation.

Water Manager Report: Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Ryan reported receiving and installing parts thus Water Salesman is now ready for use.

City Clerk Report: Clerk Ken Bergeron provided a written report and financials. Ken reported the number of delinquent accounts, and that payment was received from each account holder.
