

Dwight City Council Minutes

May 15th, 2023

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the Library on May 15th, 2023 at 7 PM. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were Peter Marquardt, Brenda Switzer, Susan Mulryan, and Absent Andrew Beamer.

Additions to agenda: Resolve temporary flooding of streets in Dwight. Scott Mulryan volunteered his labor, and will provide council a price list of materials needed. A small backhoe will be rented from United Rentals.

Minutes: Councilman Peter Marquardt moved to accept the minutes of the April 24th, 2023, regular meeting as written. Councilwoman Mulryan seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Maintenance Manager Report: No written report provided. Council discussed millings straight across at Church corner. Ken left messages twice awaiting call back for electric company to call back about Genevac generator, having red fault light.

Water Manager Report: Water Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Ryan will work on getting the unused settor returned to Core & Main. Ryan will research leak at ballfield, check where the water line is located.

City Clerk Report: Ken Bergeron updated Council on progress with training.
