

## Dwight City Council Minutes

August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the City Office on August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 7:00pm. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were Susan Mulryan, Ashley Gearhart, Peter Marquardt, Chelsey Brosious, and Adam Wiebe.

**Visitor Comments:** Mike Shinn made a verbal and written request to the City of Dwight for a copy of Year End Profit & Loss report for year 2024. Tamra Shinn inquired about balance of certain funds, as well as to bring up the amount of time she feels the roads have been neglected.
