

## Dwight City Council Minutes

October 20<sup>th</sup> , 2025

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the Dwight Public Library on October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 7:00pm. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were Ashley Gearhart, Chelsey Brosious, Adam Wiebe, Susan Mulryan, and Peter Marquardt

**Visitor Comments:** Andy Masenthin discussed with Council a former request for Morris County to vacate the Alley at 428 10<sup>th</sup> St. Mayor Goss explained to Current Council that City Council had approved this in summer of 2019.

**Minutes:** Councilwoman Gearhart moved to accept the minutes as presented of the September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025, regular meeting. Councilman Marquardt seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0

**Maintenance Manager Report:** Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Ryan reported a school bus driver from Council Grove requesting limbs to be trimmed. The limbs were trimmed, the driver returned call stating very satisfied with the trimming.

**Water Manager Report:** Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Ryan reported weeds around hydrants have been sprayed. Ryan reported on receiving and completing 811 dig orders. Ryan tested Watersaleman for accuracy, found to be very close when tested.

**City Clerk Report:** Clerk Ken Bergeron provided a written report and financials. Ken reported the number of delinquent accounts, and that payment was received from each account holder. Ken reported sending a letter to Gregory Hager in reference to sewer cleanout needing specific work accomplished. Ken informed City Council of a message left on the city answering machine. Ken reported to Council that the Bond payment was mailed and discussed updated procedures that began with the current year and moving forward for Bond Payments.

**Review and Approval of Bills:** Councilwoman Gearhart moved to approve the bills for a total of \$1,113.00. Councilwoman Brosious seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0

**New Business:** Discussion was held between City Council and Amy Oleen-Naaf concerning the Rent Contract for Dwight Library. Further discussion will be held after corrections are made to proposed contract.

Councilwoman Mulryan made a motion to accept the resignation of Councilwoman Chelsey Brosious. Councilman Wiebe seconded. Motion carried 5-0

Councilwoman Mulryan made a motion to accept the mayor's appointment of Jamie Fetters to replace Chelsey Brosious for the remainder of her unexpired term. Councilman Wiebe seconded. Motion carried 5-0
