

## Dwight City Council Minutes

March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the Dwight Public Library on March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 7:00pm. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Other council members present were Ashley Gearhart, Jamie Fetters, and John Traynor

**Additions to Agenda:** RWD #1 new rate increase of 4.77 per 1000 gal.

**Minutes:** Councilman Traynor moved to accept the minutes as presented of the February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026, regular meeting. Councilwoman Fetters seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0

**Maintenance Manager Report:** Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Ryan reported damages to sewer lines, provided photos. Ryan reported needing a battery for City Grader. Ryan provided an estimate of \$2275.00 for rental of concrete cutter at \$30.00 per week. John Traynor volunteered the use of his privately owned Concrete Cutter to be operated by Ryan Taylor. Ryan presented estimates on a wench and Mounting plate for the dump trailer.

Councilwoman Gearhart made a motion to purchase Winch for \$69.99 plus mounting plate for \$7.99. Councilwoman Fetters seconded motion. Motion carried 3-0

**Water Manager Report:** Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report. Ryan reported he will be sending water samples on 3/16.

**City Clerk Report:** Clerk Ken Bergeron provided a written report and financials. Ken reported the number of delinquent accounts, all have made a payment.

**Review and Bills:** Councilwoman Gearhart moved to approve the unpaid bills as presented. Councilwoman Fetters seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0

### **New Business:**

Councilwoman Fetters made a motion to raise the Water Base minimum rate to \$38.62 for the first 2000 gallons of water, \$7.31 per 1000 gals thereafter due to the rate increase from the Rural Water District. Councilwoman Gearhart seconded the Motion. Motion carried 3-0

Mayor Goss continues working on the 2026 budget for Council based upon the past five years of income and expenditures.
