June 15th, 2026

The Dwight City Council met for a regular meeting at the Dwight Public Library on June 15th, 2026, at 7:00pm. Mayor Pam Goss opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members present were Ashley Gearhart, Jamie Feters, Adam Wiebe and Peter Marquardt

Minutes: Councilwoman Gearhart moved to accept the minutes as presented for the May 19th 2026, regular meeting which was rescheduled from the 18th. Councilwoman Feters seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0

Maintenance Manager Report: Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report.

Water Manager Report: Manager Ryan Taylor provided a written report.

City Clerk Report: Clerk Ken Bergeron provided a written report and financials. Ken reported the delinquent accounts have all have made payments.

Review and Bills: Councilwoman Gearhart moved to approve the unpaid bills as presented. Councilman Marquardt seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0

New Business: Mayor Goss has prepared ordinance violation letters and late Dog Registration letters.

Councilman Marquardt made a motion to increase Sewer Rate from \$20.00 to \$25.00 monthly effective August 1st, 2026. Councilwoman Gearhart seconded motion. Motion carried 4-0

Councilwoman Feters made motion to Vacate Alley in accordance to Ordinance 2026-1. Councilwoman Gearhart seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Councilman Marquardt made a motion to not increase the Revenue Neutral Rate for the 2027 proposed Budget. Councilwoman Gearhart seconded. Motion carried 4-0

Old Business Mayor Goss continues working on the 2026 budget for council based upon the past five years of income and expenditures.

Open Forum: Councilwoman Gearhart to work on getting a Grant for sewer system of Dwight.

Mayor Goss informed Council Wildcat Construction has repaired manhole.
